Hydraulic Pump	Check reservoir level.	●										
Lights & Signals	Check for proper operation. Replace burnt out bulbs.	●										
Suspension	Check for worn components.		●									
Tie Down Lugs & Straps	Check for wear and general condition.	●										
Welds	Check welds for cracks or separations.			●								
Deck Descent Alarm	Check for operation.	●
