1. Tire Pressure - Inflate to pressure indicated on tire.			
2. Tire Wear - Check amount tread wear and wear pattern.			
3. Wheel Lugs - Tighten to specified torque rating.			
4. Spare Tire - Properly inflated and securely mounted.			
5. Trailer Coupler - Check components and proper closing.			
6. Coupler Ball - Check for unusual wear, lubricate if required.			
7. Hitch Safety Chains - Check for wear on links.			
8. Emergency Breakaway Cables - Check cable and all components.			
9. Trailer Brakes - Check general operation and proper adjustment.			
10. Brake Fluid (hydraulic brakes only) - check reservoir level and for hydraulic leaks.			
11. Trailer Battery - Raise the deck to check if battery low, recharge if necessary.			
12. Lights & Signals - Check for proper operation, replace burned-out bulbs.			
13. Vehicle Identification Number Tag - In place and legible.			
14. License Tag - Secure to license plate mount.			
15. Deck Latch - No damage and works properly.			
16. Deck Rollers - No damage, secure, and free of debris.			
17. Hydraulic System - Check for leaks.			
18. Hydraulic Pump - Check reservoir level.			
19. Hydraulic Cylinder - No damage and working properly.			
20. Suspension - Check for worn components or broken springs.			
21. Welds - Check welds for cracks or separations.			
22. Tongue Jack - No damage and working properly.			
23. Deck Descent Alarm - Check for operation.			
24. Enclosed Trailer - Visually inspect enclosure weldment, latch handle, and hardware for damage. (if applicable)
